In the academic year 2022-23, for Students Satisfaction Survey (SSS) on Overall Institutional performance, 21 questions were asked to learners to give their feedback.

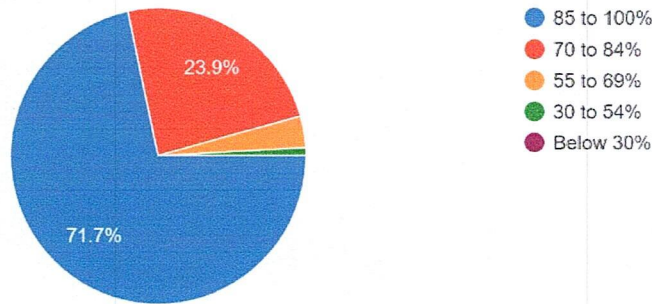

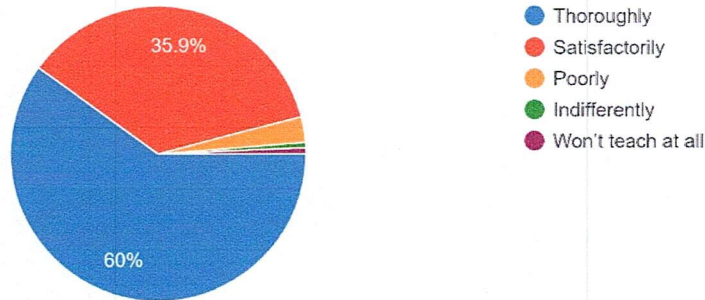

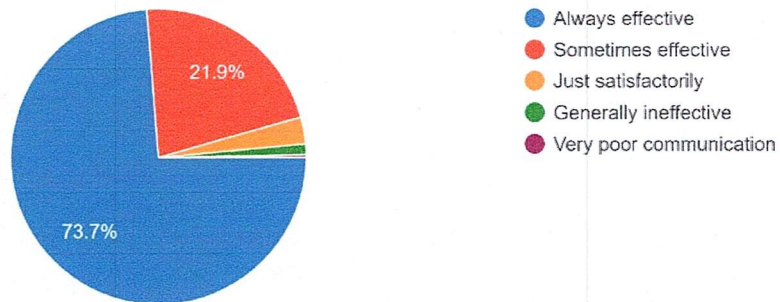

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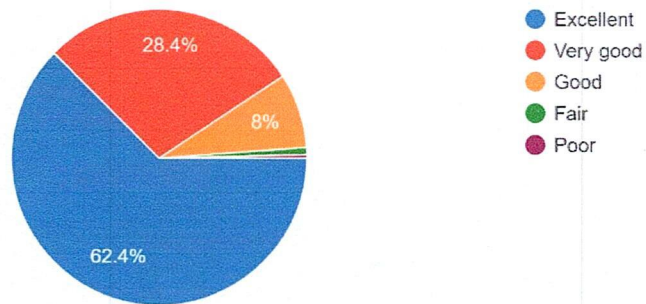

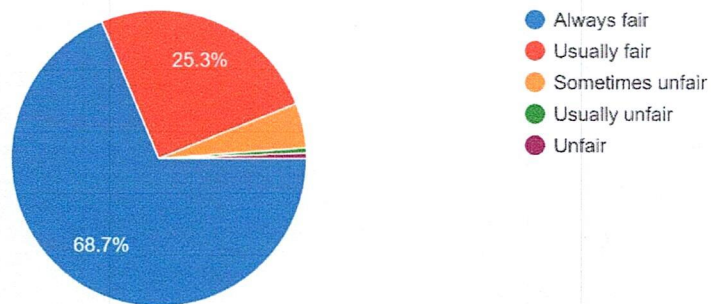

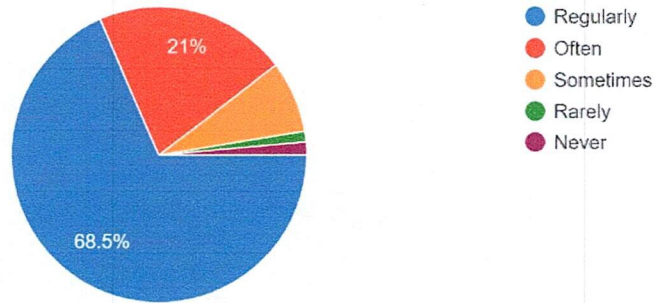


6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

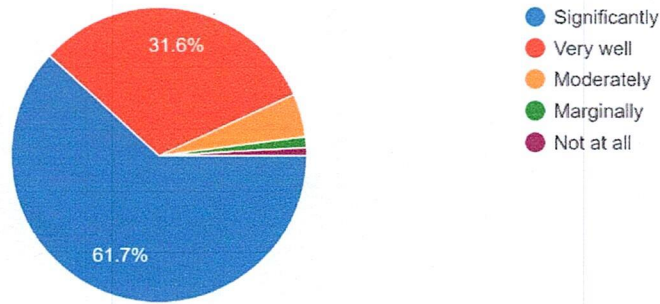

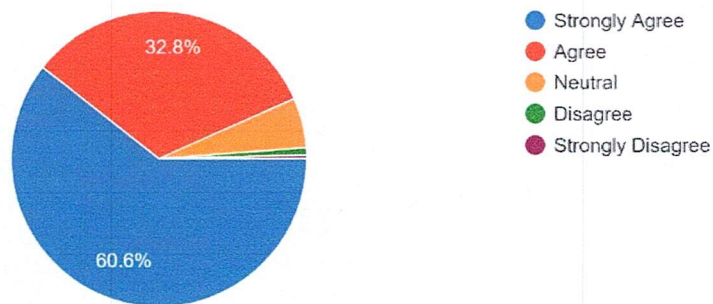

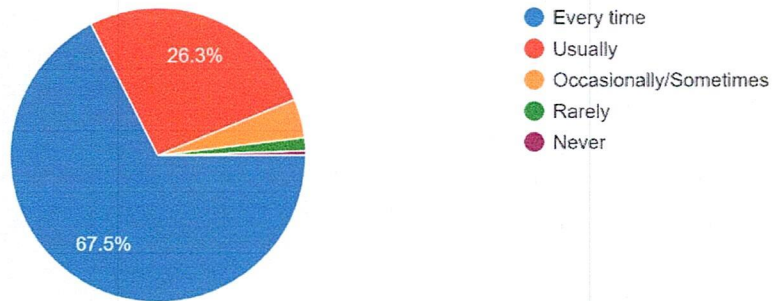

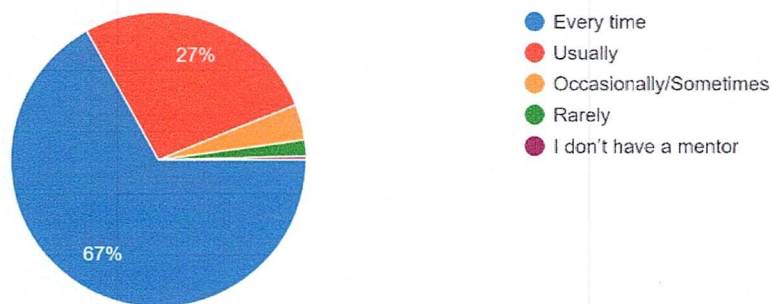

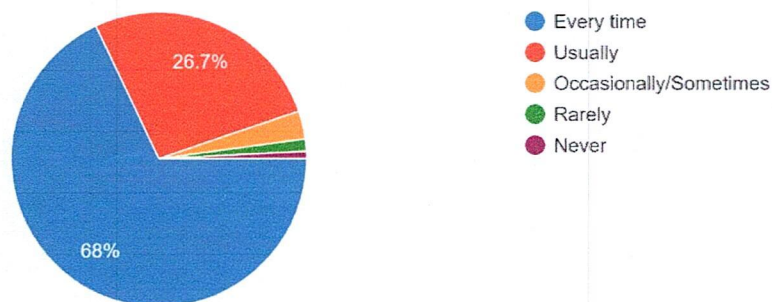

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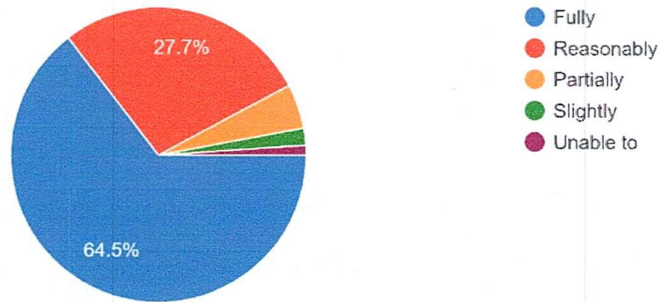

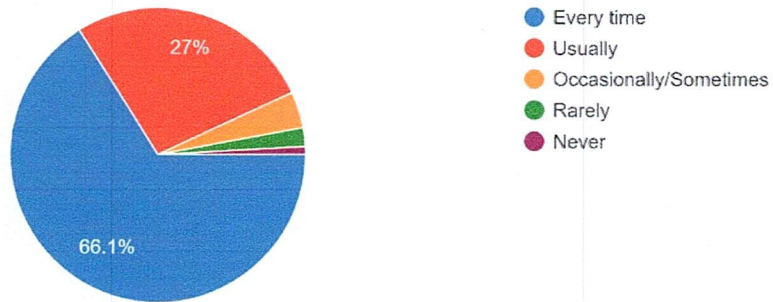

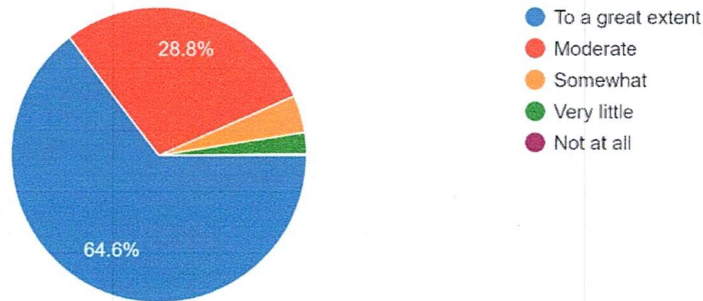

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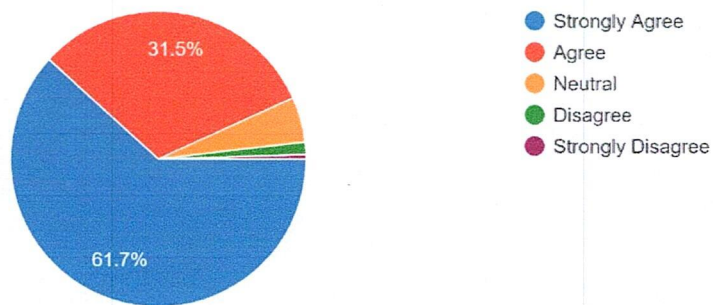

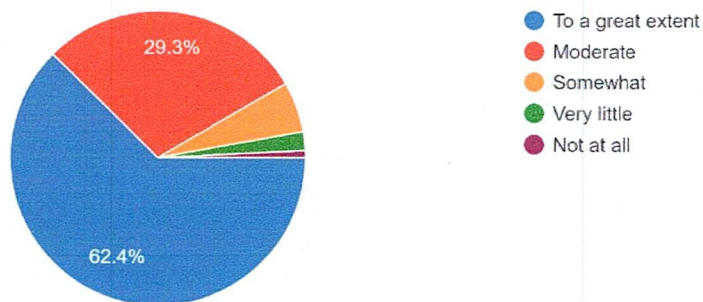

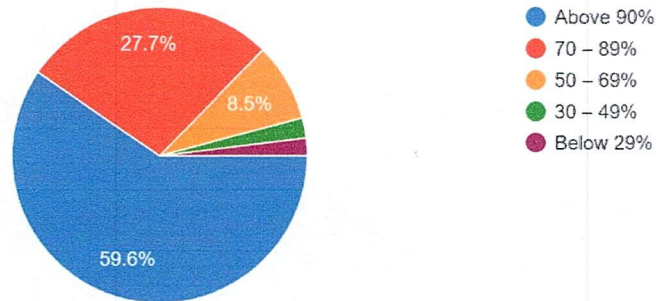

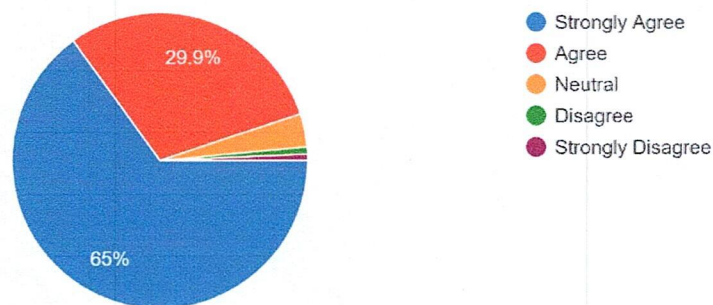
